• ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED. The product contains small parts, which are for

• Always remove protective material and poly bags and dispose before assembly.

Assembly tools required:



Screwdriver (not included)



Long nose pliers (not included)

Assembly steps



Assemble the wheel cap:

Please stuck the hubs and rim, then insert a decoration cover into the wheel cover

Attention!

If your product with Rubber wheels or EVA wheels, Please omit this step, and jump to the next step.



Assemble Frame Tube to the Pedal

Kart Body

Attach the frame tube to pedal kart body and secure with 4pcs M5x40mm screw, Ø5 washer and nut.



Assemble the Steering Rod

Slide 1 pieces Ø10 washers on steering rod, put the steering rod through the hole on front wheels joint frame then the hole on pedal kart body and out from the hole on frame tube, slide another 3 pieces Ø10 washers to the Rod. Note: The bolt and nut for Steering Wheel are preinstalled on the Steering Rod, please take them off before above assembling.



Assemble the Front Panel

Attach the front panel to steering rod with the slot on the top panel, tighten the fastener part on back with 4 pieces M4x12mm self-locking screws. Tighten the bottom side with 2 pieces M5x30 bolt and M5 nut.



Assemble the Seat

Fasten the seat on the body with

four pieces M5x40mm bolts, Ø5

washers and nuts

Use Safety

- Never use in roadway, near motor vehicles, on lawn space, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools or other bodies of water;

- Use the toy only on flat surfaces. Such as inside your house, garden or playground.
- Never use in the dark. A child could encounter unexpected obstacles and have an accident. Operate the vehicle only in the daytime or a well-lit area.
- Do not let any child touch the wheels or be near them when the car is moving .
- This vehicle has adjustable play seat belts. Please instruct children how to tie the safety belt before using, guarantee the security.



Maintaining

• It is parents' responsibility to check main parts of the toy before using, Must regularly examine for potential hazard, such as screws are fastening enclosure of other parts and that in the event of such damage, the toy must not be used until that damage had been properly removed.

- Make sure the plastic parts of the vehicle are not cracked or broken.
- Occasionally use a lightweight oil to lubricate moving parts such as wheels.
- Park the vehicle indoors or cover it with a tarp to protect it from wet weather.
- Keep the vehicle away from sources of heat, such as stoves and heaters. Plastic parts may melt.

• Clean the vehicle with a soft, dry cloth. To restore shine to plastic parts, use a non-wax furniture polish. Do not use car wax. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

• Do not drive the vehicle in loose dirt, sand or fine gravel which could damage the moving parts.
